Minutes of the October meeting were approved and attested.

Old Business: Skateboard policy: There is no town ordinance. In the Visitor's Behavior Policy no scooters, bikes or skateboards are allowed on the patio. Lee prefers to wait and revisit if a problem arises. All agreed.

Fines: Reviewed the 2017 Late and Replacement Fee Policy and Procedure. Discussed if fees discriminate, how much money they bring in and what other state libraries are doing. Lee would like to eliminate fees in July by taking it out of his budget next year.
